# BLESSING OF EASTER BASKETS

The Blessing of Easter Baskets will take place on Good Friday at 12:30 PM in the lower level of the Church.

The custom of bringing an Easter Basket to Church is an age-old tradition. It comes from the desire of the Christian community to ask God's blessing on the foods that will break the Great Fast (Lent) and from which they have abstained during this period. The religious significance attached to the foods eaten are symbolic of Christ Himself, our true Passover. Foods traditionally blessed for Easter, the feast of the Lord's Passover from death to life, are the foods which God prescribed for the ancient Passover meal: lamb, bread, wine and bitter herbs. Children's baskets of candy and eggs may be included in the blessing service.

Everything for the Easter meal may be blessed. The custom is to reserve the eating of the blessed food until after the Easter Mass. These articles are placed in a wicker basket and a ribbon or bow is tied to the handle, A decorated candle is placed in the basket and it is lit at the time of the blessing. A linen cover usually embroidered with a picture of the Risen Christ or symbol with the words "Christ is Risen" is place over the food when brought to Church.
