# Reflections on the grand jury report:

Most of you know that I am also Parish Life Coordinator for St. Elizabeth Parish in Bear Creek. St Elizabeth Pastoral Council met this week to continue forming the pastoral plan for their parish. While accomplishing some planning, considerable time was spent discussing the grand jury report issued last week. Anger, disgust, confusion, concern for our priests who weren't involved, wonderment about being able to trust Church hierarchy, all these feelings were expressed and discussed. I imagine that many of these feelings and thoughts

also exist in the faithful in this parish. One of St. Rita's parishioners told me that some of his friends asked him if he was going to continue being Catholic. He told me his response was "that shame is on them, not on me." His meaning was that while he may have felt distressed by things included in the report, his faith is in Jesus. The Church has helped him discover, nurture and deepen his faith in Jesus. If anyone would like to talk about the grand jury report, concern they may have for their children or grandchildren, or the guidelines put in place in the diocese to help keep children safe, Fr. Kevin and/or I is/are/am willing to meet with you.

On another note, all the funds being raised in this building fund drive will stay with the parish. Diocesan directives have allowed for this fund not to be assessed. Thank you and may God bless you and those you love. Tony
