Batteries: The Cold Facts


Most people only think about their car battery in the winter, but warm temperatures are actually harder on your car battery. Hot weather means high temperatures under the hood, which can accelerate corrosion inside the battery. The result? Decreased battery capacity, a weakened ability to start the engine and, ultimately, shorter battery life.

But I have a 75-Month battery, it should last that long - right? The fact is that 70 percent of batteries don't make it past 4 years. If your battery is 4 years or older, you may want to have it tested. Good news though, there are some things you can do to extend your battery life. First, keep it clean. If you see it getting dirty or greasy or corrosion building up, clean

it or call us and we'll get it cleaned for you. A dirty battery runs hotter, and that shortens its life. Also, just like any battery, running it way down or depleting it completely will greatly shorten it's life. The typical battery can only take about 10 deep cycle depletions before it fails. Because we often take short trips with lots of stops, your battery can end up not getting fully charged. This also shortens battery life. One way of helping this is to get a quality battery tender or charger and hook it up to your battery when you won't be driving it as much.

Even though warm temperatures are harder on your battery, your car requires more power to start when the temperatures are colder and the battery has to be able to provide the power. Some other tips to help your battery, especially during the colder temperatures, is to have it tested along with the charging and starting systems. Inspect your connections at the battery, make sure they are tight and in good shape.

Are You Ready for the Winter Driving?

Every year, your vehicle needs to be ready for our Pennsylvania winters. The last thing you want to do is get stranded out in the cold. There are some things you can do to help prepare yourself and your vehicle for the long cold winter months.

First, you should inspect your antifreeze to make sure it's full and clean. Inspect your hoses and belts for any signs of leaking or cracking. Run your engine to make sure your heat works properly and the engine temperature is at the specified level.

Second, inspect your tires and brake operation. When it gets slick outside, the first thing to remember is to slow down and give yourself plenty of room to stop. Proper brakes and tires will



help with this. Tire pressure will drop when the temperatures get colder. For every 10 degrees the temperature drops, you lose 1 pound of pressure! If your vehicle is equipped with a Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) and the warning light is on, inspect and adjust your tire pressures.

Third, have your battery and charging system tested. Inspect your lights, wipers and other fluids. Proper light operation will help you see and be seen as well as the wipers will help keep your vision clearer.

Finally, some good items to keep in your vehicle as an emergency kit:

- Flashlight
- Windshield scraper with brush
- Gloves, boots and blanket
- First Aid Kit
- Jumper Cables, battery charger and portable cell phone charger
- High energy snacks and water bottles
- Road flare or glow sticks
- Handwarmers

1 16oz package refrigerated flaky biscuit dough, cut into 1 1/2" pieces

1 1/2C sharp cheddar cheese, shredded

4 green onions, chopped

6-8 slices bacon, cooked, drained & cut into 1" pieces

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a 9x13 casserole dish
2. In a large bowl, beat together the eggs and milk. Add in the biscuit pieces, cheese, onions and bacon. Gently turn everything over in the bowl to evenly coat.
3. Pour everything into the prepared baking dish and bake for 25-30 minutes. You want the eggs to be firmly set and the biscuits to be puffy and golden
4. Let cool slightly and ENJOY!

NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTIONS FOR YOUR CAR

Schedule your vehicle to have the brakes and other safety components inspected at least once a year or every 12,000 miles. All of us here will have the PA Safety and Emissions test done annually, but if you drive a lot during the year, you should have your vehicle inspected more often.

There is also a manufacturers recommended service schedule for your vehicle. You can refer to your owners manual or contact us and we can look up the recommended services for you.
